Requirements:

- Experience with behavioral strategies
- Knowledge of specialized methodologies for curriculum design and instruction
- Ability to instruct students
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills
- Be a team player

Responsibilities and Duties:

- Manage a caseload of up to 20 students
- Provide special education services, per the students' IEPs
- Facilitate IEP teams for caseload students
- Write and implement student IEPs, including but not limited to the handling of assessments, data collection, behavior intervention plans, documentation, manifestation determination, etc.
- Conduct evaluation procedures for special education eligibility and 3-year reevaluations
- Monitor and report progress in IEP goals and objectives
- Support students and parents when issues arise around student placement or instruction
- Develop positive relationships with students, parents, and the staff
- Promptly relay important information to administration and parents
- Participate in the school's self-evaluation program
- Collaborate with staff to create innovative academic student projects

- Assist colleagues with the school's management as a participant in a teacher-powered collective
- Oversee and support special education paraprofessionals
- Other duties, as assigned.
